Annual Report 2009

2009 was a successful and remarkable year to IEEE, it celebrates its 125th birthday in the world. 2009 is also a healthy and fruitful year to Hong Kong Section. We were actively engaged in organizing activities for IEEE members, students, the profession and the community. There are two more chapters formed in 2009. They are Magnetics Chapter (MAG) and Product Safety Engineering Chapter (PSE). The total number of the Chapters and Joint Chapters in Hong Kong has increased to 18.

We have extended our support to help organizing IEEE conferences in China. The International Conference on Anti-counterfeiting, Security and Identification (ASID2009) is one of the flagship conferences in Hong Kong, in which the conference banquet was combined with the IEEE 125th Anniversary Dinner together on 21st August 2009. In 2009, the Section, chapters and affiliated groups have organized or co-organized over 19 major Symposium/Workshop/Distinguished Lectures and over 80 seminars and technical visits. The technical activities are well received by our members.

In 2009, there were 8 newly elevated Fellow Class members of IEEE. This year (2010), we got 3 more newly elevated Fellow Class members of IEEE. We are one of the Sections in Region 10 having more FIEEE and the fellow membership number is growing steadily. This brings the total number of Fellows and Life Fellows resided in Hong Kong Section to 55.

In awards, we feel delighted, joyful and encouraging when we learnt that the IE/PE/IA/PELS Joint Chapter was awarded with the “Outstanding Small Chapter Award” by the IEEE Power Engineering Society. On the other hand, our past chair, Professor Paul Cheung, has been appointed by IEEE to serve a Chair of the Medal of Honor Committee for a second term and by the IEEE Foundation Board of Directors (BoD) as Vice-President of the IEEE Foundation in 2010. The Medal of Honor is the highest award in IEEE (and possibly regards as highest in the IEEE field). In Region 10 Student Paper Contest, our students have won prizes in both categories. Specifically, they have won the first prize in the postgraduate category and the second and third prizes in the undergraduate category. I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate their success. I believed that our members will proud of their achievements while feeling fortunate to have them working in Hong Kong.

Finally, I would like to thank all the members of the Executive Committee, volunteers and members for their support and hard work to make the 2009 a successful year for the Hong Kong Section. Your valuable contributions are meaningful and virtual for the development of IEEE, our profession and our community.
